Create a whole sky of constellations on these yummy pan cookies!



Family ASTRO Chocolate Chip Constellations (pan cookies)

21/4 cups all purpose flour

- I teaspoon baking soda
- I teaspoon salt
- I cup butter, softened
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 3/4 cup firmly packed brown sugar
- I teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 eggs
- 2 cups (one 12-oz. package) semisweet chocolate morsels
- I cup chopped nuts (optional)

- ★ Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.
- ★ In small bowl, combine flour, baking soda and salt; set aside. In large bowl, combine butter, sugar, brown sugar and vanilla extract; beat until creamy. Beat in eggs. Gradually add flour mixture. Stir in nuts and chocolate morsels, reserve ½ cup to make constellations.




★ Bake at 375 degrees F for 20-25 minutes. Cool; cut into 2" squares or divide by constellation for giant cookies.
